

Sanitarian II

The Ledge Light Health District is looking for a motivated Sanitarian II to join our team and help enforce the Connecticut Public Health Code, Connecticut General Statutes and District Regulations. This position includes a wide range of challenging environmental duties in both urban and rural settings. Sample responsibilities (not comprehensive) include application and plan reviews, land use inspections, complaint investigations, regulated establishment inspections, preparing reports, make recommendations regarding public health matters and presenting information to the public through public speaking engagements.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree with major studies in environmental health, science, or public health.
- Registered Sanitarian Certification by the State of Connecticut.
- Certification by the State of Connecticut in Food Service Inspection and On-Site Subsurface Sewage Disposal Systems, Phase I & II.
- Extensive knowledge of the principles and practices of public health.
- Computer skills, including Microsoft Word, PowerPoint and Excel, and email capabilities.
- Ability to relate well with all segments of the public and work within a government structure.
- Ability to produce accurate work in a timely fashion.
- Strong communication, time management and organizational skills.
- Ability to understand and interpret the law, code and ordinances.
- Ability to adapt or modify work methods and standards to meet variations in controlling conditions in working towards assigned objectives.
- Ability to present ideas in an easily understood manner.
- Ability to use proper judgment and tact.
- Ability to work with the staff as a team player.
- Must have a valid driver's license.

This is a full time (40 hrs. per week), mid-level, non-supervisory, hourly, non-exempt, regular employee position.
