




WIND STORM...

A wind storm is a brief weather event with strong winds that are 50 miles per hour or more!




- -DO GO INDOORS AND STAY INSIDE

- -<u>DON'T</u> TOUCH LIGHT SWITCHES IF YOU ARE WET OR STANDING IN WATER






