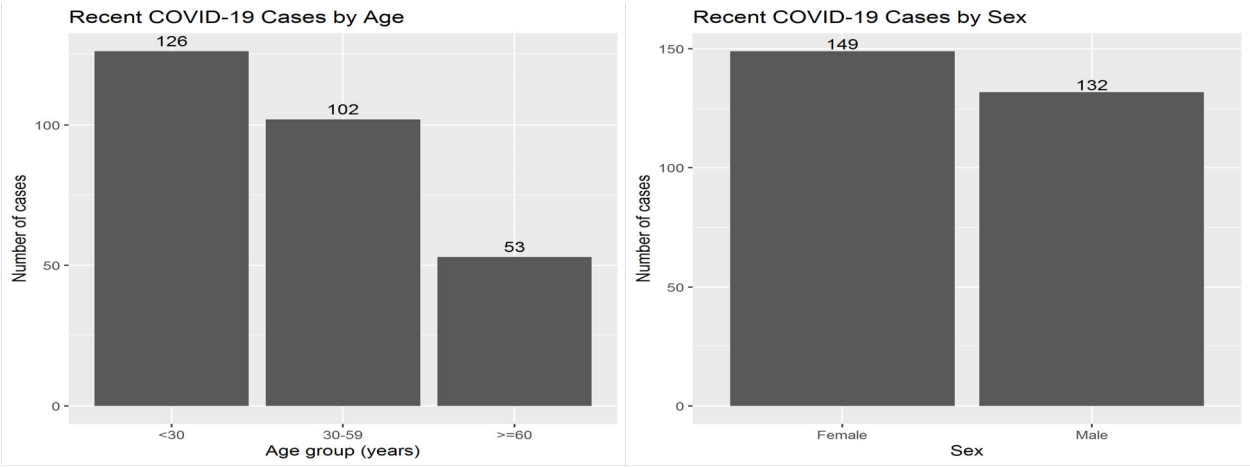

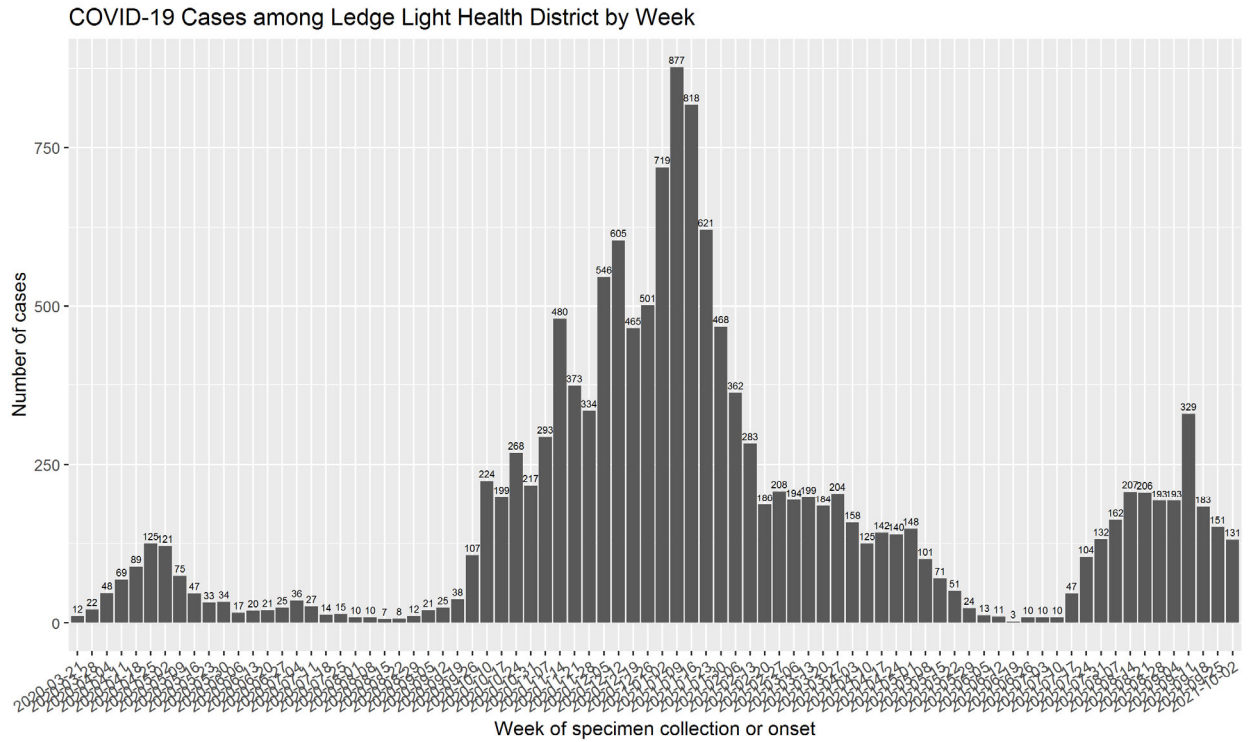
Distribution of Recent COVID-19 Cases by Age and Sex
